Products to be used:

STOMP 440 HERBICIDE

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 440 g/L PENDIMETHALIN as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Situation	Pest Plant	Rate
Maize	Wireweed (<i>Polygonum aviculare</i>)	2.25-3.4 L/ha

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply as soon as possible after planting and before weed emergence.
- Apply in a minimum spray volume of of 100 L/ha water.
- DO NOT make more than one application per crop using a boomspray.
- DO NOT use stomp 440 mixed with Atrazine on heavy clay soils.

Withholding Period:

Not required when used as directed.

Jurisdiction:

TAS only.

Additional Conditions:

This Permit provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.
